Angie Martin joined us to explain what a WAT grant is and how TUMMA members can work together to save money on training if they work together to offer training. Equity and inclusion in the application will offer a better chance to be awarded; as well as the training results in certificates.

Kevin will survey the TUMMA members on what training is of an interest and report to Angie.

Grant applications are due in April; so need to work quickly to gather information.

Value Statement for TUMMA survey results and discussion

Kevin shared the results of his quick survey to understand what is important to our Members and why they are active in TUMMA's mission.

More surveys to be sent to ask educators what connections they have made, what do educators want to know about manufacturing careers, are there any gaps that TUMMA can assist with, why do they attend TUMMA K12 Taskforce meetings, and challenges that TUMMA can help overcome.

Matt will work with Kevin on some more detailed surveys to Members and non-Members to keep working toward the development of a Value Statement.
